

Over the last three decades, Imran Khan Cancer Appeal has served as a lifeline to Pakistan's poor, offering free treatment to 75% of patients – this ensures that cancer patients from various backgrounds have access to quality healthcare.

We provide quality healthcare services to cancer patients, as well as promoting cancer awareness and research. We provide comprehensive cancer treatment, including surgery, chemotherapy, radiotherapy, and supportive care. The hospital is equipped with modern facilities and technologies for diagnosis and treatment.

Our first hospital, the Shaukat Khanum Memorial Cancer Hospital & Research Centre (SKMCH & RC) in Lahore, Pakistan, was founded by Imran Khan in memory of his mother who passed away due to cancer. We now also have a fully functioning hospital in Peshawar and a new hospital is being built in Karachi that is going to be double the size of Lahore.

Our doctors conducted a thorough screening to confirm the initial diagnosis and promptly initiated a comprehensive treatment plan – a plan that will last at least three years. Aqib's family was relieved and grateful to learn that his treatment costs would be covered by our donors.

Furthermore, we try to limit the amount deducted from donations whenever we can through revenue received from our hospital diagnostic services and other means. Our donors also help us do this by allowing us to reclaim Gift Aid on their behalf if they are UK tax payers
